- Must have never been married
- Must not have any children
- The applicant must not be a current title holder of any other fair, festival, or pageant at the time of the Andouille Pageant

- **Attire is Dressy Casual (A group photo will be taken for the newspaper)**

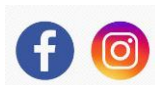
